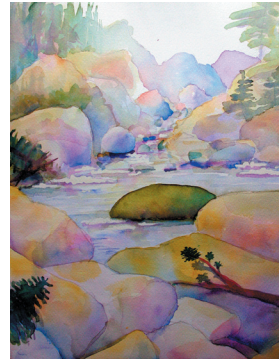

I joined Artists in Action and have served as Treasurer, Vice President and President." She enjoys gardening, travel, bird watching, photography, literature, and most of all, interpreting her surroundings through her art.



Artist Statement

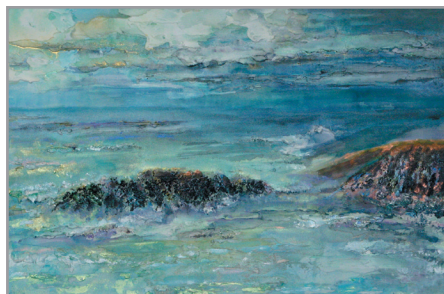
I am an abstract expressionist as well as representational artist. The use and manipulation of natural elements, color and texture drive my work.



My works are often anchored with natural pigments such as ground lapis, azurite, manganese, and vermilion. My abstract expressionist paintings are created in a meditative state, and evoke a spirituality that cannot be otherwise expressed.



The representational works are meant to inspire senses beyond sight, such as the taste and feel of the salt air; the sound of crashing waves, the fresh and pungent smell of mountain forest and meadow; the subtle sounds, smells, and sense of touch manifested by a soft breeze, as well as the energy of rushed moments. With painting, I feel that I am honoring my purpose.

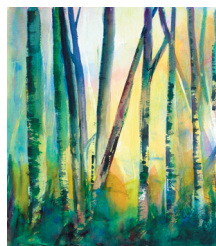

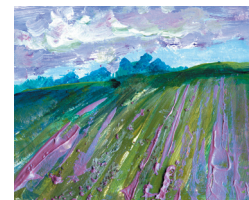
